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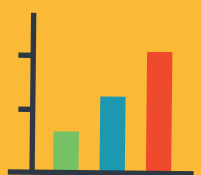

FAQs

Q1 Will the Programme be cancelled if the outbreak of pandemic gets worse or remains unstable?

A: Participants' health and safety will always be our top priority. We will keep updating participants on our latest decision. Cancellation will be announced no later than 8 July 2020 if needed.

Q2 If the Programme is cancelled, will there be a refund?

A: Yes, there is a refund policy issued by cheque. The refund policy will ONLY include the programme fee. The refund policy will NOT cover the Application Fee or any expenses incurred in relation to the application of the programme, including but not limited to travel expenses, visa fees and health insurance. The Secretariat will also not be responsible for any losses caused by the cancellation.

Q3 What precautions will you take to ensure a safe and clean environment?

A: The Institute premises and facilities will be disinfected at least twice daily. Participants will have to submit health declaration form every day. Participants who have fever or respiratory symptoms will not be allowed to attend the training. Health Ambassadors will be assigned in each group to raise participants' awareness on personal hygiene.

Q4 Will surgical masks be provided?

A: Hygiene materials such as hand sanitiser gel will be available on site. Participants are advised to wear their own surgical masks which will also be available upon request.
