## Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) eLearn Award Scheme 2022

Translating SDGs into actions, UNICEF HK organizes the SDGs eLearn Award Scheme. Through an eLearn platform and self-directed learning, the Scheme allows students to take online lessons on different SDGs and commit practical steps in daily life in support of sustainable development of local community and the world.

#### 1. Aims

- To promote the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals, to educate students and raise their awareness on global issues;
- To nurture global citizenship by fostering students' commitment and actions in support of the Sustainable Development Goals; and
- To encourage self-directed learning, and to connect online and offline learning experience.

#### 2. Details of the Scheme

- (a) All secondary schools are welcome to nominate students to participate in this Scheme. No upper limit is imposed on the number of nominated students.
- (b) A 'personal learning account' of UNICEF HK eLearn Platform will be created for the registered students. They can access learning materials at the platform. The platform records their learning progress and performance so as to facilitate students' checking.
- (c) The SDGs eLearning Award Scheme is comprised of two components:
  - Learning
    - Complete the online course 'Learning about sustainable development and find your purpose'
    - 2. Complete the online course 'Learning about 17 SDGs'
  - Taking Action

Complete SDG actions to achieve Gold, Silver or Bronze Award

The SDG courses and actions will be released in March, April and May.

### • Student Awards

Students accomplishing certain number of online courses and actions will be awarded Gold, Silver or Bronze Certificate.

- Gold: Completed 2 online courses and taking at least 6 actions
- Silver: Completed 2 online courses and taking at least 4 actions
- Bronze: Completed 2 online courses and taking at least 2 actions

#### **Most Active Contribution Award**

- In addition, the 'Most Active Contribution Award' will go to the top 10 students with action accomplishment via the eLearn Platform.
- Awardees will receive \$300 book voucher and a certificate.

## **Best Participation Awards for Schools**

- The 3 schools with the highest number of participating students\* will be awarded.
- Awarded schools will receive \$1,000 book voucher and a certificate.
