Prior to starting AI, we have used a few Apps like Raz Kids, Nearpod, Plickers, Kahoot and others with the students from P1 to 6.



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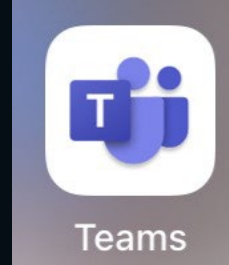

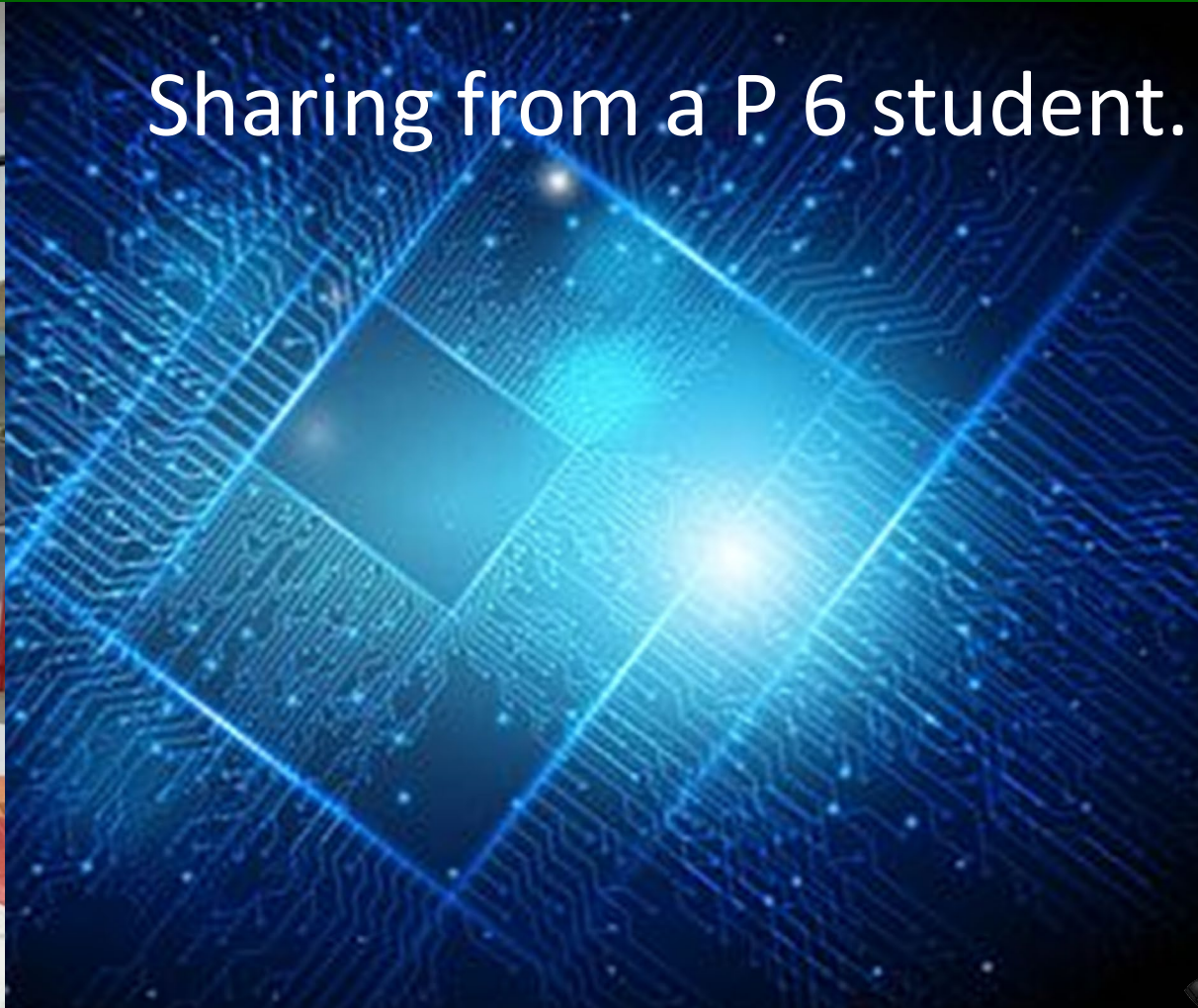
For the final day, I want to do something memorable so I decided that I'm going to take a picture of every single place I went and every food I ate. Also I will buy an album to store all the pictures I took.
