A. Is Hong Kong facing an unprecedented challenge?

- Through the study of similar historical events, students will be able to realize that
 the situation faced by Hong Kong is not unprecedented. This approach also
 clarifies some misunderstandings about the spread of atypical pneumonia.
- Students are asked to complete one of the three activities according to their abilities.

B. "Atypical" globalization

- Students will be able to understand certain key features of globalization in the express spread of atypical pneumonia on a global scale.
- With reference to international cooperation in dealing with the spread of atypical pneumonia, students will be able to reflect on the limitations of individual countries or regions in resolving global problems.
